



Casa Tua Méditerranée is officially open

Casa Tua Méditerranée's professional kitchen crew, with food consultant Kiki Valvis, worked tirelessly to present rich and varied mezethes for tastings, a selection of Greek, Spanish and Arab appetizers against the musical backdrop of Angela Croes' flamenco music, also featuring six gorgeous Oriental dancers. The veiled dancers in fitted tops decorated with fringes, beads and coins, wearing equally fitted hip belts with more fringe, beads and coins over colorful harem pants, entertained party goers all night, and invited them to also shimmy their hips, vibrating and swinging, as if they were all born in the Middle East!

Casa Tua Méditerranée offers a contemporary Mediterranean style. The décor, by Daveed Nataf, features dark wood, straight-lined furniture, on the outdoor wrap-around terrace and in the air-conditioned dining room. The polished concrete used on the floor also serves as a bar top, in shades of pearl grey. The large bar top is suspended, over a band of indirect lighting, to create a luminous, glowing effect that works well with the metallic sheen of the bar's back wall. The ceiling features a number of hanging layers, giving the room an interesting, architectural look. The restaurant has no walls as it is completely encased in glass allowing excellent views into the Palm Beach Plaza.
